**FRIENDLY REMINDERS**

1. Before reading, always check the Lectionary to ensure that that it is on the correct page matching the readings I sent you. Also, ensure that the sheet for the Prayers of the Faithful is near the Lectionary.
2. We are not to say, “First Reading”, or “The First Reading is....” or “Responsorial Psalm”, or “The response to the Psalm is”....
3. Please check with the musicians if they will sing the Responsorial Psalm and the Gospel Acclamation and the verse before the Gospel. If not, read the Responsorial Psalm and the verse before the Gospel. Check with the priest to make sure that he will sing the Gospel Acclamation “Alleluia” before you read the verse.
4. Please pause after the First Reading (3 to 5 seconds) before going on to the Responsorial Psalm (it not sung). You should conclude each reading (First and Second Readings) with a slight pause followed by the phrase “The Word of the Lord”.
5. Before you read, please check with the priest as to the assigned readings in case there are changes.
6. **Bow to the altar before and after you read.**
7. **If you cannot make the Mass assigned to you, please try to switch with another reader and let me know so I can let Father know.**
