

SACRAMENTS Baptisms:

Starting the first Sunday of December, Baptisms will be every Sunday@ 12:30pm. Parents and Godparents to be married in the Catholic Church, and parents to be registered parishioners for at least two months.

Baptism Class attendance is mandatory by the parents if you have not previously taken the class.

You will need to register for a Baptism Class by calling the parish office during office hours.

Baptism Classes are the third Sat every month @ 10:00am except for March 2022. The class will be held on March 12.

REFLECTION ON THE READING:

In Tobit's instruction to his son he says, "Do to no one what you yourself dislike." (Tob 4:15) Jesus did not rest content with this attitude. He calls us to a more profound transformation of heart. "You're your enemies; do good to those who hate you; do to others what you would have them do to you!" From now on, no one is to be excluded from our love, not even avowed enemies. Charity must not be quibbling or calculating love. It is more than humanitarian virtue. Jesus is the ultimate expression of divine mercy. He pardoned his executioners from the cross. Only in following his example are we capable of responding to hatred with good, to curses with blessing, to ill-treatment with prayer. To Love in this way is to love the other into life. It is to invest our love freely, without seeking return. It is to love with eyes open for what is unique and good in each person. It is to love by giving up the last word, by accepting the risk of being duped, by knowing how to pardon beyond knowing calculation.

Sto. Niño de Cebu at St. Anthony of Padua, Agassiz This year marks the 500th Anniversary of Christianity in the Philippines, and we are very pleased that Father

Dennis Flores, Pastor of St. Anthony of Padua in Agassiz, in collaboration with the Filipino Ministry Office of the Archdiocese, has envisioned building a pilgrimage Shrine of Sto. Niño de Cebu as a gift to the Archdiocese of Vancouver built in Agassiz. The hope is that many pilgrims will be able to take advantage of this site, and to enliven their faith and strengthening their devotion to the Sto. Niño. The estimated cost of this project is \$400,000, and all funds required must be in place before construction can commence. The ground breaking is scheduled for March 20, and Fr. Dennis has a goal to have it completed by August 2022. The image of Sto. Niño will be brought from Cebu, Philippines for enthronement at that time.

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name.


With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts;
