



We have now reached our archdiocesan goal of **\$52,800** and all additional pledges will be returned to the parish to try to meet the **overall goal of \$190,000**. To date we have reached **\$164,727**. Your support will now help our own parish special project which this vear includes the completion of the air cooling unit to the current HVAC system in the church. Due to budgetary restraints 12 years ago, air cooling was not seen as a priority at the time, but recently we are seeing a trend of warmer & longer summers ahead. It would be good to complete the system and bring about a well functioning system all year round. There are only 5 weeks left to donate to Project Advance before the end of the year. 


