THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

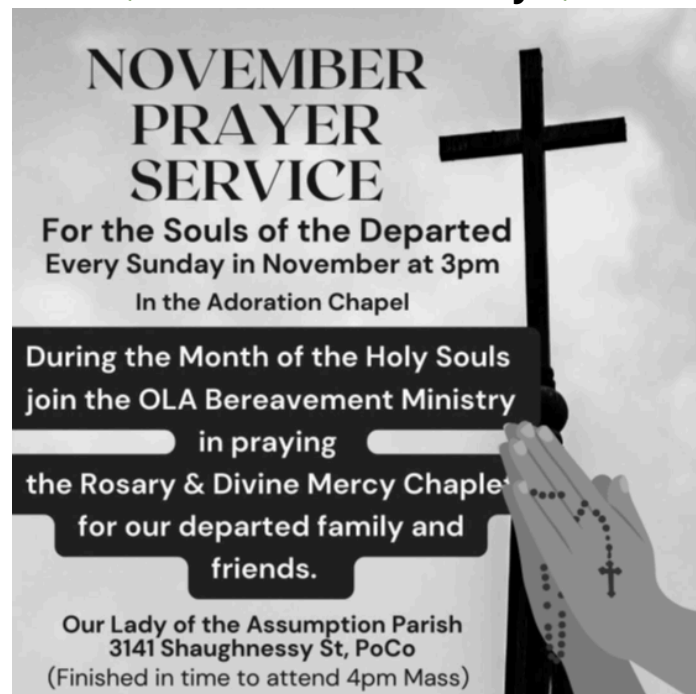
