



THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

- Baptisms are every Sunday@12:30pm. Parents and Godparents are to be married in the Catholic Church, and parents need to be registered parishioners for at least **two months.** Baptism Class attendance is mandatory for parents if you have not previously taken the class. You will need to register for a Baptism Class by calling the parish office during office hours. Before attending the Baptism Class you must fill out the Baptism information form.

ASH WEDNESDAY MASSES: (Blessing and distribution of Ashes) Wednesday, Mar.5th, 9:00am & 7:00pm. Ash Wednesday is a day of prayer, fast and abstinence. Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of Fast & Abstinence from meat. The fast (one main meal & 2 small meals with no snacks throughout the day). Fasting binds all those from 18 years of age to 59 years of age. Abstinence binds those 14 years of age & above. Fridays are days of penance & the first form is abstinence from meat, but if that is not possible, an act of increase of prayer or charity is to be its substitute.

Lenten Devotions Tuesday's @ 7:00pm Stations of the Cross led by a priest will begin Mar. 11th until Apr.8th.


