THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

- Baptisms are every Sunday@12:30pm. Parents and Godparents are to be married in the Catholic Church, and parents need to be registered parishioners for at least **two months.** Baptism Class attendance is mandatory for parents if you have not previously taken the class. You will need to register for a Baptism Class by calling the parish office during office hours. Before attending the Baptism Class you must fill out the Baptism information form.





Archbishop's Message for the Federal Election

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On Monday, April 28, Canadians will elect our next federal government. I encourage all Catholics in the Archdiocese of Vancouver to participate thoughtfully and prayerfully in this democratic process. Our faith does not align itself with any political party, but it does compel us to be engaged citizens. Each of us has an obligation to form our consciences guided by Church's social teaching and seeking the common good of all, especially the most vulnerable.

To help you prepare, I encourage you to use the resources provided by Catholic Conscience, a non-partisan organization dedicated to helping Catholics bring Gospel values into public life. Their 2025 Federal Election Guide presents a helpful comparison of party platforms through the lens of Catholic social teaching and offers reflections on key issues such as the sanctity of life, care for creation, economic justice, religious freedom, and the dignity of the human person.

EASTER MESSAGE 2025

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

"The death and resurrection of Jesus is the heart of our faith and the basis of our hope. Saint Paul states this succinctly by the use of four verbs: "I handed on to you as of first importance what I in turn had received, that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, and that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas and then to the twelve" (1 Cor 15:3-5). Christ died, was buried, was raised and appeared. For our sake, Jesus experienced the drama of death. The Father's love raised him in the power of the Spirit and made of his humanity the first fruits of our eternal salvation. Christian hope consists precisely in this: that in facing death, which appears to be the end of everything, we have the certainty that, thanks to the grace of Christ imparted to us in Baptism, "life is changed, not ended", forever. Buried with Christ in Baptism, we receive in His resurrection the gift of a new life that breaks down the walls of death, making it a passage to eternity."

It is precisely in the Easter message that the greatest of our hope rests. It is God, through the liturgy active and present, that encourages to maintain our focus on hope through the Cross of Jesus, God always fulfills His promise.

Today's world gives us every reason to doubt and even become very discouraged amidst the uncertainties we face both politically, socially, and economically. Our Catholic faith calls us to turn to Jesus in prayer so that in the time of trial we may be given the strength to endure what seems even impossible. Jesus fought through the temptations to stop under the weight of the cross—the weight of our sins by prayer to His Father.

Let us continue to deepen our relationship with God through our daily prayer, Catholic devotions and practices; so that even if we don't see the results we want, we will be given the unfailing strength to bear our crosses with true hope!
